


## Understanding the English Sentence: The Clause



This book begins as an insight into the four main functions that must occur (noun and verb) and can occur (adjective and adverb) inside the English clause. Once one understands the function and how that function is identifiable inside the clause, one can proceed to understand how a single word or a group of words fulfills that function inside a sentence since a sentence can be composed of one independent clause or of two or more independent clauses or of any number of independent clauses along with any number of dependent clauses. This book attempts to uncover the underlying structures that create the meaning conveyed in a sentence not by focusing on the eight units called the parts of speech, but rather by exploring the types of structures that compose the four main functions within an entire sentence. Finally, in its third part, the book establishes the only available grammatical units that can fulfill any one of these four functions. Each section reiterates the functions covered and progressively expands on how those functions apply to the understanding of the English sentence by way of the definition of a clause.
