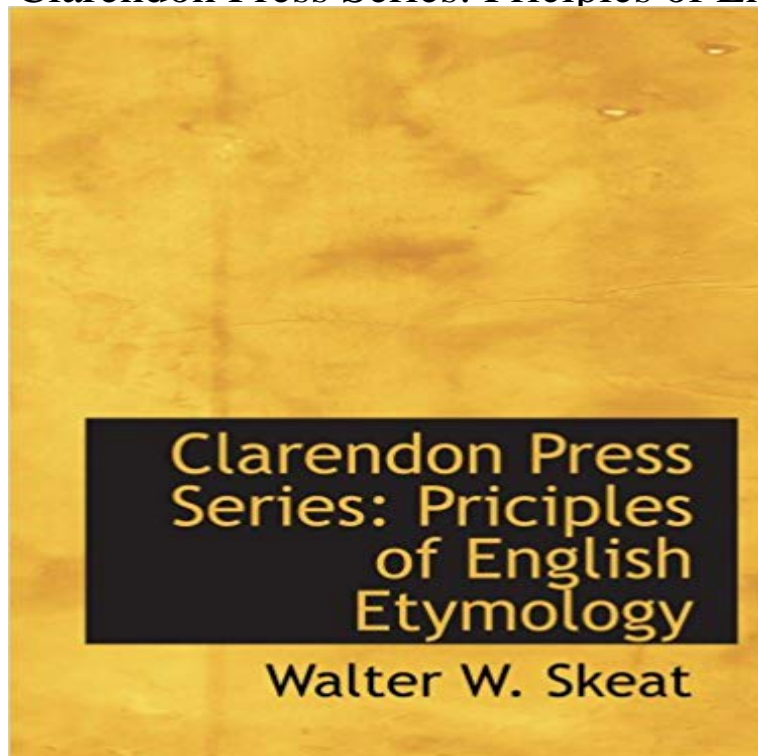


## Clarendon Press Series: Principles of English Etymology
