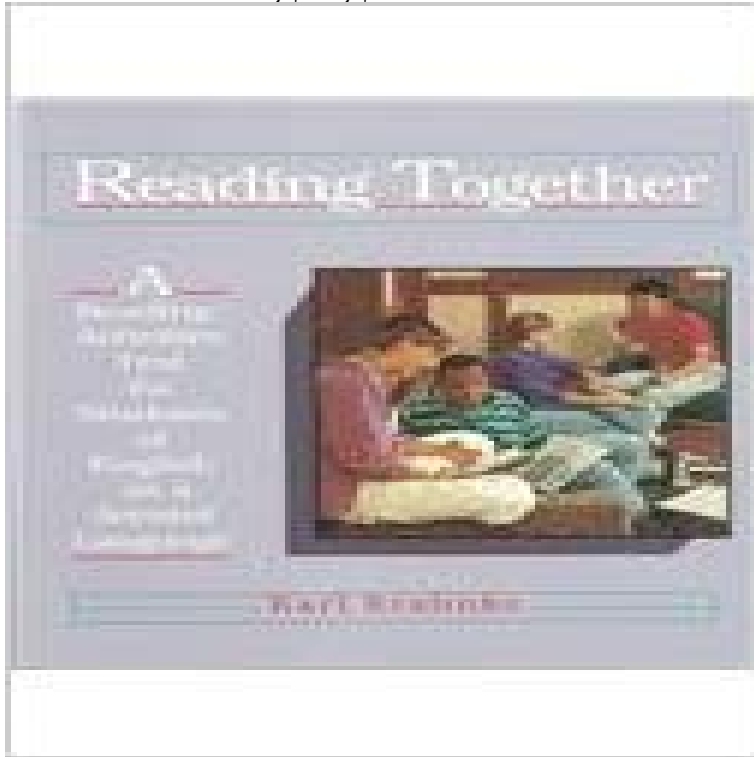


Reading Together: A Reading/Activities Text for Students of English As a Second Language



Each of the chapters is devoted to one general topic & includes a variety of readings & activities. The final chapter contains readings that are taken from published sources with little or no adaptation; the activities in the final chapter are also more research-oriented. Students are exposed to vocabulary repeatedly & in a variety of topic-related contexts. Vocabulary is not pre-taught, in isolation, but encourages mature & productive meaning-discovery strategies. Learners experience a variety of writing styles & points of view on a given topic. Requires students to work cooperatively.
