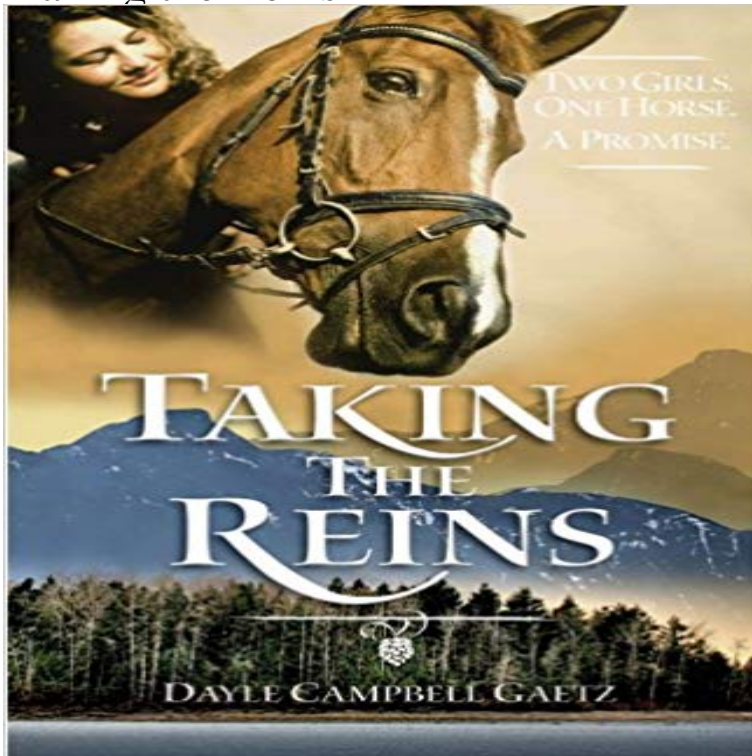


Taking the Reins
